Students in Year 10 undertake a programme of study comprised essentially of all the core subjects and selected electives. Students in Year 10 are also able to include in their course of study a range of VCE Units suited to their interests and abilities.

This means that the VCE is spread over 3 years, rather than 2, enabling students to tailor their own, individual programme for these three critical senior years. It also means that students in Year 10 can sample subjects more widely than they would otherwise be able to. Students must meet published criteria to be eligible to study a VCE subject.
